Ah, how's it going? Gentlemen, this is Scot McKay from X & Y Communications. And you're tuned in to another snippet from the summit as part of The Mountain Top Podcast. Today, I want to talk to you about something that I've been, I don't know, let's just say it's been on my mind for a while. And I'm not sure it's ever been called out after Wow, 25 years plus of men's dating advice. It seems to me that every time you look at men's dating advice, and it talks about the kind of women we're approaching, and attracting, and hoping to date and yes, hoping to have sex with. It's unbelievable to me how it almost always focuses exclusively on women in bars and clubs, in either Los Angeles or Miami. It's crazy. And here's the thing, it seems like we as guys fall hook line and sinker for this limited scope of discussion.
